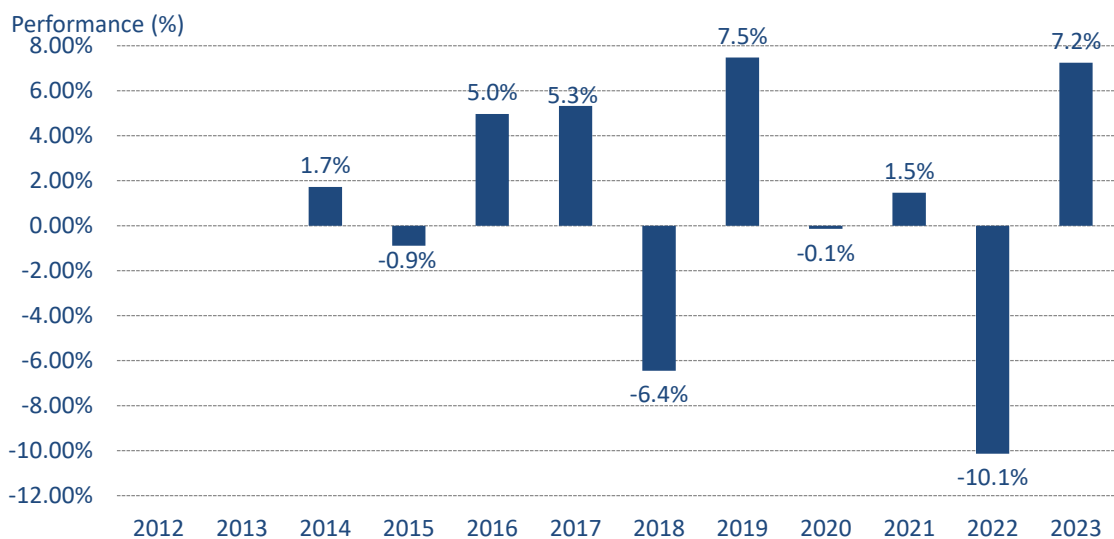

High Income Bond Fund - class A

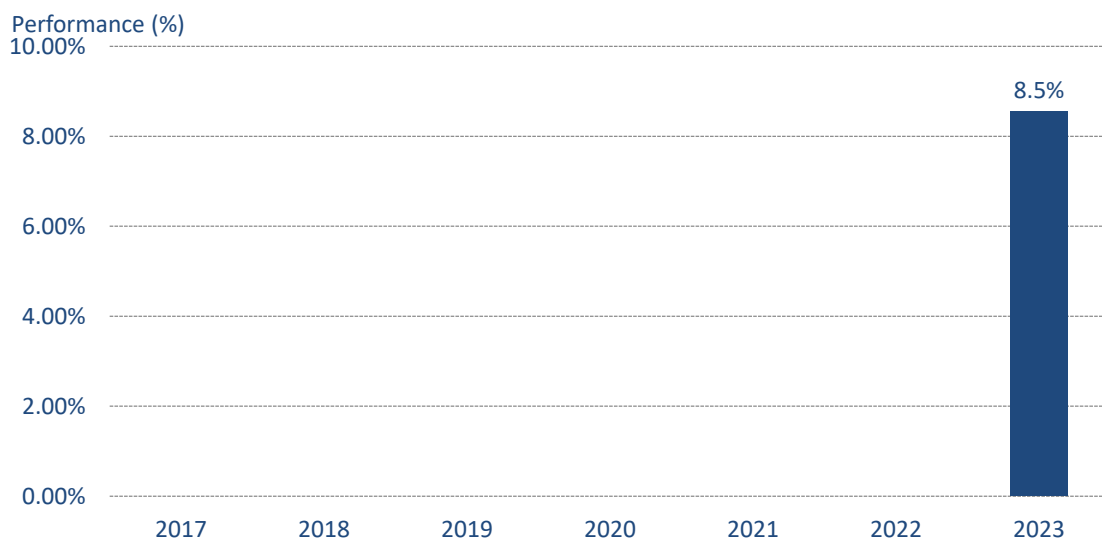

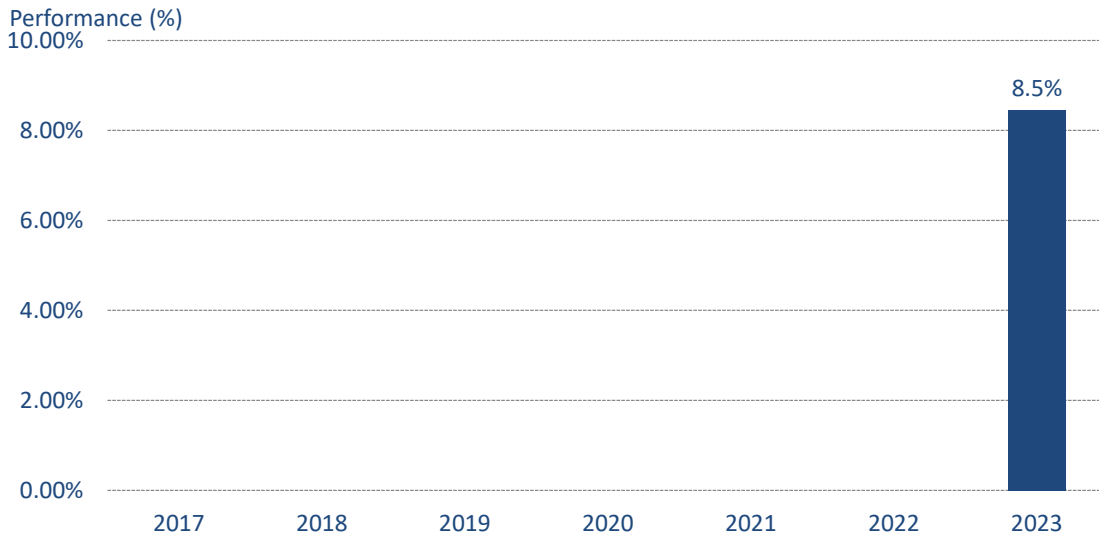

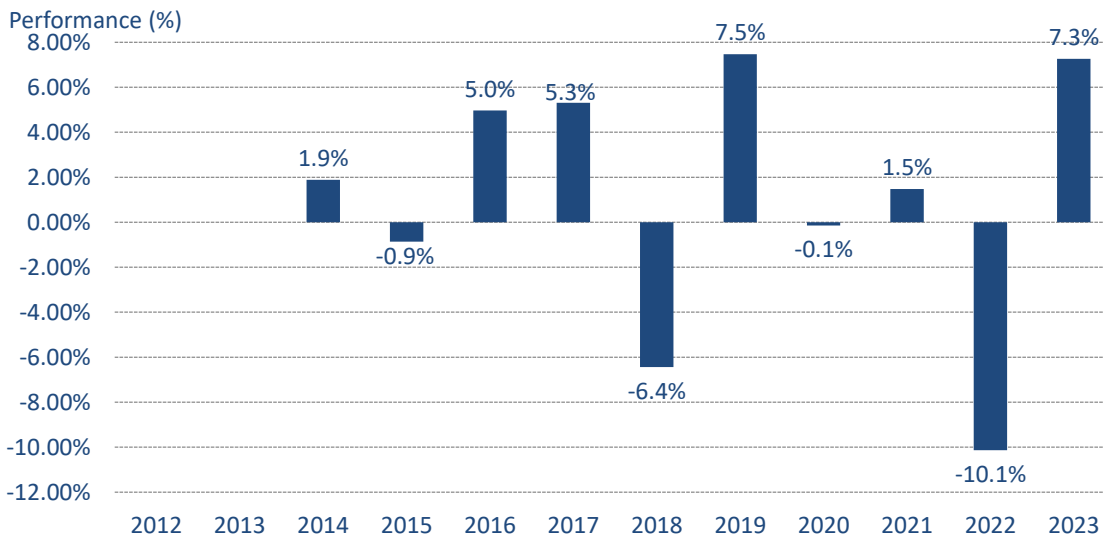

High Income Bond Fund - class C



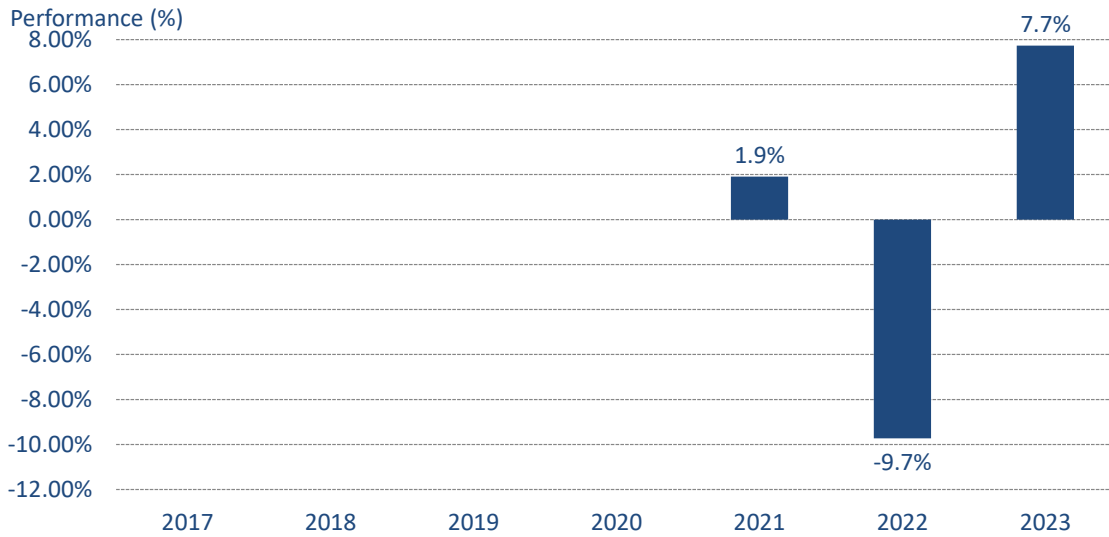

High Income Bond Fund - class D



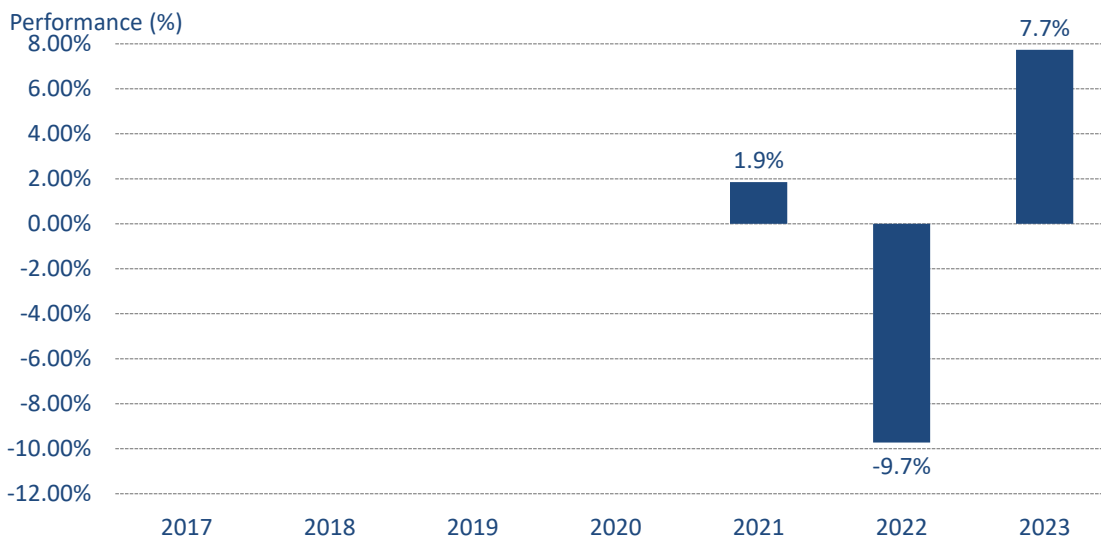

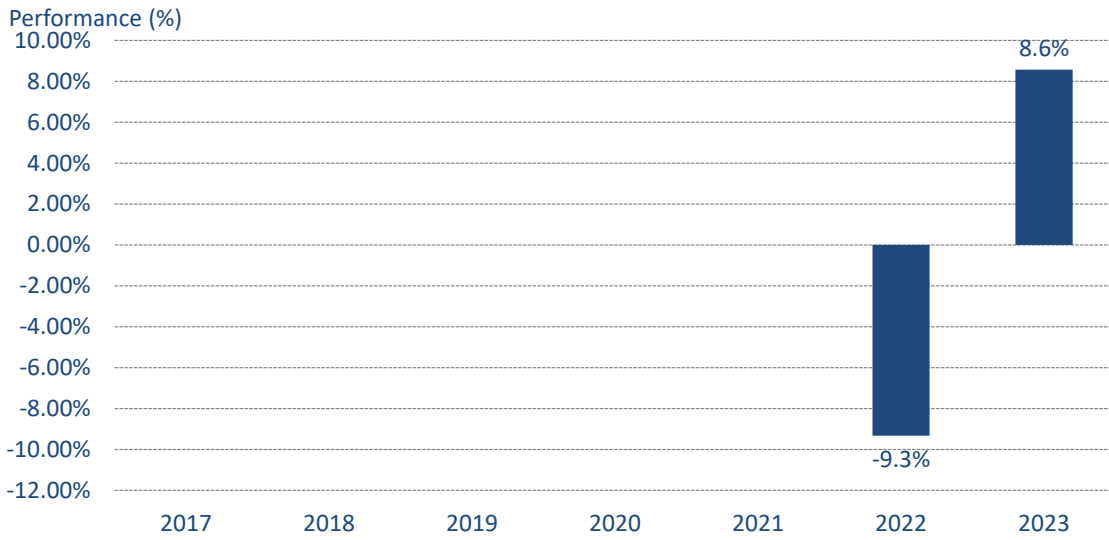
